The Need:

"But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing." 2 Corinthians 4:3 NKJV

The vast majority of all who respond to the Gospel do so before turning 20. It is imperative for youth to hear the plan of salvation while they are most receptive.

There are more than 41 million 10-19 year olds in America's 3,141 counties.

Over 400,000 in that age group live within 100 miles of TTT in 93 Illinois, Indiana, and Kentucky counties.

A recent study reveals that 8th graders in small town and rural areas are more likely than their urban counterparts to use alcohol and drugs. Rural areas are especially vulnerable to meth because the strong odor can be hidden more easily. Drug dealers find it easier to operate in small towns, and drug smugglers are moving into rural areas. Eighth graders in those areas are more than twice as likely to have smoked, and more than five times more likely to have used smokeless tobacco. Over twenty percent have used alcohol and seventy percent of those have been intoxicated.

These are major factors leading to sexual promiscuity, and STD's are taking a terrible toll.

Prayer and sharing the Gospel can turn the tide!

The Plan:

TTT uses every possible means and media to get the Gospel to youth. The most effective is teens telling teens the Truth. TIGER*Team Training in peer evangelism and Christian leadership is ongoing at TTT. When committed Christian adults are trained as K.E.Y. youth evangelism coaches, they can make a far reaching and lasting impact.

Jesus walked, talked, and taught twelve (and one of these betrayed Him). And then He selected 70 to take the Gospel in pairs.

After Jesus' death, burial and resurrection, for 40 days He



Students put Bible books in order continued to teach and challenge — “Go into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature.” Just before He ascended into Heaven to return to His Father, He promised: “But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.” Acts 1:8 NKJV

In just a few days, the betrayer, Judas Iscariot who had hanged himself, was replaced by Matthias. Then came Pentecost. Peter preached and 3,000 responded to the invitation to “Be saved from this perverse generation.”

“And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.” Acts 2:47

They kept going with the Gospel, and soon addition changed to multiplication. “And daily in the temple, and in every house, they did not cease teaching and preaching Jesus as the Christ. Now in those days, when the number of the disciples was multiplying.” Acts 5:42-6:1a

For over 2,000 years, the multiplication of Christianity has continued. Now, it’s our turn!

The Result:

Acts 13:47-49 sets the stage for us: “For so the Lord has commanded us: ‘I have set you to be a light to the Gentiles, that you should be for salvation to the ends of the earth.’ Now when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad and glorified the word of the Lord. And as many as had been appointed to eternal life believed. And the word of the Lord was being spread throughout all the region.”

Multiply Your Ministry is being launched the week of January 28-February 4, 2012 for 100 weeks – through December 28, 2013 (TTT’s 2,500th consecutive Saturday, God willing). TIGER*Team IMPACT! evangelistic youth efforts will continue to get the Gospel to and through teenagers, week-by-week.

MISSION: POSSIBLE – The objective is to triple people and participation through Hosanna Highway at TTT April 5, 6, and 7.

Multiply Your Ministry evangelism and training thrust continues, including preparations for Fair Share.

The goal is to take teams to 20 county fairs and street festivals in 2012. Tri-state Travelin’ TIGERS will be joined by a team from Teen Missions International.

TTT is also sponsoring Motorcycle Sunday School Mission units in 11 African villages, reaching hundreds of AIDS orphans each week.
